

[IMPORTANT] Notice to Applicants

Please carefully note the following instructions regarding the entrance examination for this Graduate School.

1. Application Procedure

Applicants are required to contact their prospective supervising faculty member in advance. If the faculty member deems it necessary, the applicant will be required to take an online written examination. Please note that not all applicants will be assigned to the written examination.

2. Written Examination

- **Date and Time:** Tuesday, January 20, 2026, 15:00–17:00 (Japan Standard Time)
- **Duration:** 2 hours
- **Subjects:** Classical Mechanics, Quantum Mechanics, Electromagnetism, Thermodynamics, and Statistical Mechanics
- **Language:** English (written answers)
- **Purpose:** To assess whether applicants possess the fundamental academic knowledge required for research at the graduate level

3. Examination Method

The examination will be conducted online. All applicants subject to the written examination must prepare the following environment:

- Stable internet connection (wired LAN or Wi-Fi)
- Personal computer equipped with a webcam and microphone
Windows PC OS : Windows11(24H2) or greater
Browser : Latest version of Edge or latest version of Chrome
Mac PC OS : macOS12 or greater
Browser : Latest version of Safari or latest version of Chrome
iPad OS : Latest version of iPadOS
Browser : Latest version of Safari
- Mobile phone with a camera (mandatory for examination monitoring) + smartphone stand
iPhone Latest version of iOS + Safari
Android Android14 or greater + Chrome

An AI-based monitoring system will be used to ensure fairness and integrity of the examination. Applicants are required to consent to this monitoring. **Those who do not provide consent will not be permitted to take the examination.**

4. Notification of Details

Further details, including instructions for assessing the examination and submitting answers, will be individually communicated to applicable applicants after completion of the application procedure.

5. Handling of Examination Results

The results of the examination will be used by the prospective supervising faculty member to assess the applicant's fundamental academic ability and will serve as a reference in determining acceptance into the laboratory.

All applicants must contact their prospective supervising faculty member in advance and follow their instructions.
